2. Quality of Research Project (40% of total score)

Criteria: Please consider...

- Is the applicant's research project an educational training opportunity?
- Applicant's written description of this project (well-versed? Logical? Interesting?)
- Feasibility and overall quality of the project
- Project's alignment with Cumming School of Medicine's research agenda and strategic direction.

3. Quality of the Training Environment (20% of total score)

Criteria: Please consider...

- The location, the learning environment, and other trainees that are provided to the applicant.
- Opportunities for mentorship and/or collaboration by graduate students
- Supervisor's research, publication track record, and current and/or previous funding

N.B. Preference is given to junior faculty members, where the funding would facilitate the development of the supervisor's research program.
